City of Columbia CDBG- Mitigation Infrastructure Program CDBG-MIT Funds, Disaster Relief Requirements Act of 2018, Public Law 115-123 Mitigation Infrastructure Review **Public Comment Period: July 26, 2023 – August 25, 2023**

In accordance with the federal regulations, 84 FR 45840, the City of Columbia is preparing to amend the City of Columbia Community Development Block Grant- Mitigation Infrastructure Action Plan. The City of Columbia announces a public comment period to review the proposed amendments to the programs. The purpose of this period is to allow the public an opportunity to review and comment on progress, achievements and expenditures of the federal CDBG- Mitigation Infrastructure and Action Plan.

The City defines substantial amendments to the Action Plan as those that

propose one or more of the following changes:

- A change in the purpose, scope, location or beneficiaries of an activity approved in the Action Plan or subsequent amendment;
- The allocation or re-allocation of more than \$1 million; or
- The addition or deletion of any allowable activity described in the approved plan

Citizens will have the opportunity to review the proposed amendments to the City of Columbia CDBG-Mitigation Infrastructure Plan beginning July 26, 2023 at <u>http://mit.columbiasc.gov</u> or request a copy from the Community Development Department.
